What We Do

As Myplas expands globally, it has launched a work skills exchange with its partner facility in Rogers, Minnesota — a state-of-the-art recycling plant opened in late 2023. South African staff train there on advanced recycling equipment and processes, while U.S. colleagues gain from Myplas's deep expertise in plastics recycling. This two-way exchange transfers insights and best practices, fostering innovation and strengthening operations in both countries.



Our Impact

- Knowledge Transfer: The Myplas SA designed and installed facility requires Myplas to train US based technicians in plastic recycling and managing the plant.
- Technical Skills & Leadership Development: Staff who join the exchange build not only technical know-how but also leadership and project management experience. Operating in an international context pushes them to problem-solve in new ways, manage at scale, and bring back efficiency and quality improvements. Many become internal champions and mentors, strengthening Myplas's South African workforce.
- Continuous Improvement: Lessons from the U.S. are applied directly at home – from optimizing production lines and improving recovery rates to raising safety standards. This continuous feedback loop keeps Myplas competitive, resilient, and globally connected. The programme proves that South African enterprises can both learn from and contribute to international advancements in the circular economy.
