

# Recycling for a Cause: Sweethearts Foundation Partnership

## What We Do

Through its partnership with the Sweethearts Foundation, Myplas helps turn plastic waste into mobility and dignity. The Foundation's nationwide "Tops & Tags" campaign collects plastic bottle caps and bread tag clips. Myplas purchases and recycles this plastic, and the proceeds fund the donation of wheelchairs for people with mobility impairments. This initiative links environmental cleanup with direct social upliftment — showing how the circular economy can change lives.



## Our Impact

- **Mobilising Waste into Wheelchairs:** Bottle tops are collected and converted into funding for wheelchairs. Hundreds have already been delivered, while significant amounts of plastic have been diverted from landfills and put to meaningful use.
- **Community Collection & Awareness:** With collection points at schools, churches, and businesses nationwide, the campaign mobilises widespread participation. Communities not only learn about recycling but also contribute to a tangible humanitarian goal — raising awareness of both disability needs and waste reduction.
- **Supporting Mobility and Dignity:** Each wheelchair represents restored independence for a recipient, often a child or person who had limited mobility. By giving waste a financial value, Myplas ensures the plastic collected translates into meaningful equipment, supporting both social and environmental progress.
